

- Direct pupil support, whole school EAL audit, training courses and CPDs, e.g. EAL New Arrivals Assessment, EAL-SEND, Talking Partners, developing the role of EAL Coordinator, bespoke training packages, GCSE exams in first languages represented within the team, bilingual services and home – school liaison

GRT services: DSG funded for maintained primary schools, traded to academies & secondary schools

- Outreach work to families on local authority sites, private sites and unauthorised encampments with regard to education
- Integrated teaching support in collaboration with teaching staff including planning, delivery and evaluation
- Supporting the assessment of highly mobile short stay pupils
- Advising and supporting schools in their preparation and monitoring of distance learning packs
- Advice on cultural resources which can be purchased or produced
- GRT cultural awareness training
- Mentoring
